1. FACULTY CHANGES NAME

Directorate of Distance Education and Open Learning (DDEOL)

The Copperbelt University Senate at its meeting held on Tuesday, 21st July, 2009 approved the change of faculty name from Centre for Life Long Education to Directorate of Distance Education and Open Learning. This is in line with the current trends internationally as well as the activities that the faculty indulges; vis-à-vis specializes in Part time/Evening and Distance programmes.

2. STATISTICS OF GRADUATES

The Copperbelt University has continued to experience an increase in terms of graduate output year by year.

The University graduated a total of 714, this year, 2009 at a colourful ceremony held on Friday, 24th July 2009.

The breakdown for each of the Faculties is as follows:

The significant increase in the number of graduates has been due to the introduction of new programmes where students were graduating for the first time, namely:

- Bachelor of Science in Purchasing and Supply, School of Business.
- Bachelor of Science in Banking and Finance, School of Business in conjunction with Zambia Institute of Bankers. The first crop of graduates was in 2005 whilst this one is the second.
- Bachelor of Science in Agro Forestry, School of Natural Resources.
- Bachelor of Science in Marketing by Distance Learning – Directorate of Distance Education and Open Learning.
- Bachelor of Business Administration by Distance Learning, Directorate of Distance Education and Open Learning.

- Master of Business Administration, Graduate Studies in conjunction with (ICTAR) – University of Lusaka.
